SUMMARY:

Lake Tahoe Unified School District seeks to hire an Introductory Science Teacher for South Tahoe High School. Successful candidates will have a Single Subject Credential in Biological Sciences or supplemental authorization(s) in the subject area(s) as well as experience in integrating engineering principles to comply with the Next Generation Science Standards in California. A credential in Geoscience (with experience in Earth Science) is also preferred. Experience in developing and initiating project-based learning modules will be helpful.

DESCRIPTION OF PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Position requires normal physical strength and endurance for standing, sitting, bending, and walking. Position may require sitting or standing for extended periods of time, for example when working at a desk, conference table, small student classroom table, or in meetings in various configurations.
- Vision sufficient to read printed materials; hearing and speech sufficient to conduct normal in-person and telephone conversations as well as presentations.
- Requires mobility of arms to reach and dexterity of hands to grasp.
- Work assignments are normally located in a work environment with light physical activity and require light physical effort.
- May require lifting 25 pounds maximum or carrying any object weighing over 15 pounds.

SALARY AND BENEFITS:

The entry-level range on the 2021 – 2022 Certificated Salary Schedule is \$52,786 – \$74,912, with an additional amount of \$1,927 granted annually for each post Baccalaureate degree. Salary will be prorated to reflect the actual duty days of the late-start assignment. The benefits include subsidized Medical/Prescription, Dental, and Vision for employee and family, plus Life Insurance (for employee only).
