Minimum requirements:

Must be a full time student-Spring transcript must show 12 units taken as well as registered for 12 units in the upcoming Fall semester

Bilingual Required (Spanish/English)

Maintain a 2.3 GPA- (must submit transcripts)

Available to work flexible schedule, full days and weekends as needed (June-Mid July, up to 40 hours weekly)

Possess a valid California Driver's license and proof of current insurance

Access to or use of reliable personal vehicle.

Be able to communicate effectively and utilize training received into action performed

Examples of Duties:

Provide summer services (GEMS, CAMPS, REACH and classroom assist) to students and work directly with families and school staff to improve students' ability to succeed in school. Maintain documentation of services and activities.
