A Plumber performs skilled plumbing work in the installation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of District plumbing equipment, devices and fixtures.

Plumbers perform skilled plumbing work in the installation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of District plumbing equipment, devices and fixtures. Some of the primary responsibilities that plumbers will perform requires that he/she:

- Installs, replaces, maintains, and repairs plumbing systems, equipment, appliances, controls, and fixtures including water, gas, and sewer installations.
- Works from sketches, drawings, and blueprints to install, maintain, and repair equipment, devices, and fixtures such as vacuum breakers, backflow devices, gas appliance safety controls, gas piping to steam tables, plumbing fixtures, drains, sinks, sumps, circulatory pumps, water heaters, and showers.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs gas piping systems for space heating.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs automatic, semi-automatic, and manually-operated lawn-sprinkler systems.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs air and gas welding systems

Successful completion of a recognized plumbing apprenticeship program or five years of experience in plumbing construction, installation, alteration, or repair work, of which one year must have been at the journey-level.

#### SPECIAL:

A Los Angeles City Journeyman Plumber License.

OR

A Los Angeles County Certificate of Registration as a Journeyman Plumber.

**Minimum Requirements** 

#### SPECIAL PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Ability to stand, walk, bend, crawl, climb, reach overhead, crouch, kneel, balance, push, pull, and safely lift and carry items weighing up to 100 pounds

Agility to work in confined spaces of buildings, climb high ladders, and work from scaffolds

Normal sense of smell to detect natural gas, stagnant water odors, sewer/septic gas odors, and odors associated with methane gas.

All employees must be fully COVID-19 vaccinated and must be able to provide verification of their vaccination status as part of the hiring and onboarding process prior to an official offer of employment to any District site; this includes current employees who are being promoted to a new job class.

The ideal Plumber candidate will possess a strong understanding of the job-related knowledge related to:

- Tools, materials, and skills of the plumbing trade
- State and local regulations pertaining to plumbing standards
- Safety practices and regulations pertaining to the plumbing trade

Additionally, we are seeking candidates with a demonstrated ability to:

- Make accurate measurements and computations
- Interpret and work from drawings and sketches
- Work effectively with others

The selection process tentatively consist of a computer based multiple choice test. Candidates who are successful will be placed on the eligibility list for the position.

IMPORTANT: The application deadline will be determined once we receive a sufficient number of qualified applications to meet the hiring needs.
