DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:

To help students learn subject matter and skills that will contribute to their development as mature, able, and responsible men and women.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Credential: Single Subject Credential in Social Science or Multiple Subject Credential with Social Science Added Authorization
2. Education: Bachelor's degree, including all courses needed to meet credential requirements.
3. Experience: Student Teaching (8 semester hours or 180 clock hours) or two years of full-time secondary classroom teaching experience.
4. Favorable recommendations from student teaching supervisors and/or other professionals who have observed the character and/or scholastic attainment and/or classroom performance of the teacher.

DUTIES:

1. Teaches specific subject areas as assigned.
2. Provides planned learning experiences in order to motivate pupils and best utilize the available time for instruction.
3. Develops lesson plans and instructional materials and provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each pupil.
4. Maintains an effective balance of freedom and security to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
5. Evaluates pupil's academic and social growth, keeps appropriate records, prepares progress reports, and communicates with parents on the individual pupil's progress.
6. Identifies pupil needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve health, attitude, and learning problems.
7. Creates, with assistance from pupils, a functional and attractive environment for learning through displays, bulletin boards, and learning centers.
8. Maintains professional competence through participating in inservice education activities provided by the district and/or self-selected professional growth activities.

9. Participates cooperatively with the principal or his designee to mutually develop the system by which all certificated personnel will be evaluated in conformance with the district's uniform guidelines for evaluation and assessment as required by law.
10. Selects and requisitions books, instructional aids and instructional supplies, and maintains required inventory records.
11. Ensures a comfortable room environment through control of heating, lighting, and ventilation to the best extent possible.
12. Instructs pupils in out-of-classroom activity in conformance with school rules and regulations.
13. Administers group standardized tests in accordance with the district testing program.
14. Participates in curriculum and other developmental programs within the school of assignment and/or on a district level.
15. Shares in the sponsorship of student activities and participates in faculty committees.
16. Participates cooperatively in planning and coordinating the work of teacher aides, teacher assistants and other para-professionals.
17. Under the immediate direction of the site administrator, participates in emergency supervision.
