**POSITION: Auditory Verbal Therapist**

#### **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

Under the supervision of the Special Education Director and site Principal, the Auditory-Verbal Specialist will direct and implement an Auditory-Verbal Therapy program. Through this program, the specialist will provide individual and family therapy based on the principles of Listening and Spoken Language Specialists, Auditory-Verbal Therapy, teach parents and family members in-home support practices for the student with their hearing device(s), work as an active member of the Individual Education Plan (IEP) team, assess students, track the progress of students in the program, maintain case files and create reports.

#### **Duties:**

- Required to implement an Auditory-Verbal Therapy program for each child on their caseload, which must include parent(s)/guardian(s) in each session.
- Utilizes an interpreter to facilitate coaching of parents.
- Required to undertake ongoing professional development and mentoring while maintaining LSLS Cert AVT or AVED.
- Provides Auditory-Verbal Therapy mentoring AUSD DHH certificated staff
- Required to integrate learned skills and work with the multidisciplinary team.
- Will adhere to the philosophy, policy and procedures of Alhambra Unified School District
- Will maintain all necessary records and work with administration and support staff as required.
- Provides therapy to the individual child and parent/caregiver on a regular, ongoing basis, to administer standardized assessments, and to conference with parents to set agreed outcomes.
- Acknowledges and provides for the individual needs of each student and family.
- Prepares an Individual Education Plan for each student, as well as an Individual Family Service Plan once a year for each student.
- Will attend relevant staff meetings, in-service days and parent education meetings.
- Other duties as assigned.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:**

- Possess the ability to work cooperatively as an interdisciplinary team member.
- Possess excellent communication and time management skills.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues, administrators, students, families, team members, community agencies, and others.
- The ability for flexible work schedule to accommodate parent and student sessions.

#### **EDUCATION, LICENSES, CERTIFICATES**

- Education Specialist, Audiologist, or Speech Language Pathologist Credential
  - Listening and Spoken Language Specialist (LSLS) certification required.
  - A valid CA Driver's License to transport to different work sites
- Employee must be available to begin working upon selection. If under contract from another district, the employee must show proof of release from their contract in order to be selected.
- AUSD requires all employees to have the COVID-19 vaccine.

- Experience with school-age population;
- Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech Pathology;
