Desirable Qualifications	<p>Ability to read and work from drawings, schematics, and sketches, in addition to being able to make sketches of broken parts for replacement; possess a working knowledge of the Department of California Highway Patrol, Biennial Inspection Terminals (BIT) Program and schedule preventive maintenance inspections of equipment and vehicles; and possess experience and knowledge of Type I School Bus (ABS) Air Brake Systems, suspension, and steering components; prefer Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification; possess a working knowledge and ability to perform repairs on vehicles that use alternate fuels such as Compressed Natural Gas (CNG); demonstrate the ability to properly fuel and defuel CNG vehicles, properly install various high and low pressure CNG components, and troubleshoot basic CNG component issues.</p>
Experience	<p>Minimum of four years of comprehensive experience performing a full range of fleet mechanic skilled work on heavy duty and light gasoline and diesel powered vehicles and equipment.</p>

PHYSICAL DEMAND	<p>Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
