Job Description:

The Mathematics Academic Intervention Teacher (MAIT) will teach 4 math remediation classes. Additionally, they will have one period to push-in/pull-out to work with small groups. The MAIT will work with grades 6-12, until desired content mastery is achieved.

Examples of Duties and Skills Needed:

Duties/Skills may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Works with students to remediate in a support classroom setting, as well as one-on-one and in small groups (push-in/pull-out during non-classroom time).
- MAIT must have a thorough understanding of math up through Integrated Math II. *(MAIT candidate must pass required school site math exam prior to being hired).*
- Must be organized, professional, and able to work collaboratively with teachers, tutors, and RSP staff.
- Must be able to manage students, keeping them on task and working at all times.
- Must be able to manage a large caseload of students, develop individual learning goals, and organize group and individual sessions. The MAIT must meet all instructional remediation minutes required for each student.
- The MAIT must be able to analyze and use benchmark data to achieve growth targets.

Experience and Education:

- Hold a single subject credential in Mathematics **or** be intern eligible.
- Bachelor's degree
- Have experience working with k-12 students.
