Coaching Duties and Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be expected to direct all phases and levels of the lacrosse program. The candidate will teach athletes to perform sound, safe, fundamental techniques of lacrosse. Additional duties will be to provide off-season conditioning and maintain a high degree of professional standards. The Mission Viejo High School athletic community maintains high expectations and is highly supportive of athletes.

Professional Minimum Qualification:

- Evidence of successful varsity coaching experience at the high school, community college, or college university level (references are required).
- Evidence of technical knowledge of lacrosse.
- Ability to communicate lacrosse fundamentals using a variety of coaching techniques.
- Experience in working with other athletic support group.
- Experience in working with and promoting a positive lacrosse program to the community.
- Knowledge of CIF rules, high school athletic policies, and all school rules and regulations.
- Evidence of knowledge of coaching theory and child psychology.

Personal Qualifications:

- Personal conduct emphasizes qualities of loyalty, honesty, ethics, integrity and sportsmanship.
- Demonstrates a positive role model for staff and students, conducts themselves at all times in an exemplary manner, choosing carefully appropriate language during practice and at events.
- Demonstrates dedication and commitment to a successful lacrosse program.
- Demonstrates ability to work cooperatively with parents, teachers, students and school administrators.
- Places high emphasis on student academic development in addition to physical development.
- Uses positive methods to give encouragement.
- Shows self-discipline, respect and restraint in stressful situations involving officials, players, coaches, parents, and spectators.
