LIFESTYLE STATEMENT

San Gabriel Community Church and Christian School ("SGCS") requires its employees to be born-again Christians, living their lives as Christian role models (Rom. 10:9-10; 1 Tim. 4:12; Luke 6:40). Employees will conduct themselves in a way that will not raise questions regarding their Christian testimonies. A Christian lifestyle should reflect the biblical perspective of integrity and appropriate personal and family relationships, business conduct and moral behavior. An employee is expected to demonstrate a teachable spirit, an ability to share love for others, a willingness to live contentedly under authority and a commitment to follow the Matthew 18 principle when an issue arises with fellow employees or management.
