JOB TITLE: Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN)

# **DESCRIPTION OF BASIC FUNCTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Under direction, perform a wide variety of nursing duties; perform specialized health care procedures and duties as assigned by the supervising school nurse on students. Does related work as required.

**SUPERVISOR:** Supervising School Nurse

### **IMPORTANT AND ESSENTIAL DUTIES:**

- 1. Perform specialized health care procedures as indicated in procedure protocol.
- 2. Assess students for acute and chronic health problems as requested by school staff and supervising school nurse.
- Report student health concerns to supervising school nurse. Contact family/agencies to make appropriate referrals as directed by supervising school nurse.
- 4. Note health concerns, assessment data, family/agency contacts on student health cards.
- Record direct student contact for assessment on Medi-Cal billing logs.
- 6. Assist supervising school nurse in ordering health supplies, developing student health care procedures and protocol, and assessing classroom environments for safety and hygiene.
- 7. Perform other duties as requested by supervising school nurse.

# **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**:

#### **Knowledge of:**

- Modern medical terminology, equipment, and techniques including physical assessment skills.
- Acute and chronic health conditions and medications commonly used for these conditions in the pediatric population.
- Interpersonal skills using tact, patience, and courtesy.
- Public health agencies and local health care resources.
- Health and safety regulations.
- Operation of specialized medical equipment.
- Record-keeping techniques.

# **Ability to:**

- Perform a wide variety of nursing duties.
- Perform specialized health care procedures according to established procedures protocol.
- Record data and information.
- Assist in screening students for vision, dental, and immunizations.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Read, interpret, apply rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.
- Maintain current knowledge of technological advances in the field.
- Work independently.

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### Ability to, cont.:

- Prioritize and schedule work.
- Report to supervising school nurse to assure appropriate follow-up of student health concerns.

# **EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Equivalent of the completion of graduation from an accredited Vocational Nurses Training program.
- Minimum of one year related experience.
- Four (4) years home health nursing in pediatrics or equivalent experiences desired.
- Possess a valid California driver's license.

# SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Essential duties require, but are not limited to, the following physical abilities:

- Hear and understand speech at normal levels and on the telephone.
- Speak so that others may understand at normal levels and on the telephone.
- Operate assigned machines and equipment.
- See to perform nursing duties.
- Stand, walk, and bend over, kneel, crouch, and reach overhead, grasp, pull and move.
- Lift and/or carry moderately heavy objects.
- Assist students in wheelchairs.

# **WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

Employees in this position will be required to or exposed to the following:

- Work indoors in a standard school classroom environment.
- Dissatisfied or abusive individuals, occasionally parents or staff.
- Blood and other body fluids.
- Potential contact with blood-borne pathogens and communicable diseases.
- Chemicals including antiseptics and disinfectant.
- Direct contact with Sutter County Superintendent of Schools staff, district office staff, and the public.
